Financial Incentives

Tax Credit/Rebate: Reduction in tax payments (either by direct credit or reduction in taxable income) or a possible refund in the case of a rebate

Grant : Direct grant given against a percentage of the initial cost of the roof top solar PV system

Loan : Low interest loans for the initial cost of the system

Performance Based : Such as net-metering schemes, it pays the system owner based on the energy production
