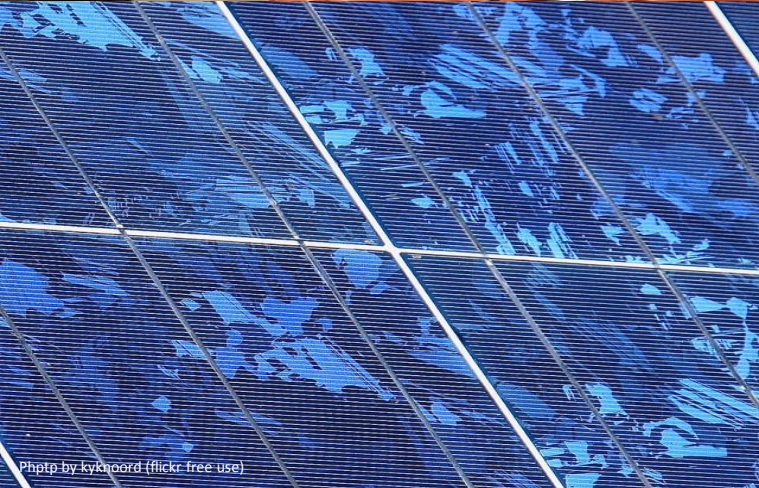

## Financial Incentives

**Tax Credit/Rebate:** Reduction in tax payments (either by direct credit or reduction in taxable income) or a possible refund in the case of a rebate

**Grant :** Direct grant given against a percentage of the initial cost of the roof top solar PV system

**Loan :** Low interest loans for the initial cost of the system

**Performance Based :** Such as net-metering schemes, it pays the system owner based on the energy production



## Financial Incentives

- ❑ Differ with each country/region
- ❑ Can be a powerful tool to grow the market
- ❑ Allows commercial entities to invest in funding residential rooftop projects
